NOTES FROM ILO JIM TAYLOR

New York, New York FIP

The latest news from New York 2016 [see side bar for dates and details] is that the competitive frames are heavily oversubscribed. Apparently 6,200-frame applications have been received by the Commissioner General for the 4,000 frames available. Some of the frames will house the invited Court of Honour exhibits and remember that the FIP has set aside 20% of the available competitive frames for first time international exhibitors. Also 5% may be allocated to youth exhibitors. The final selection of accepted exhibits will be made in in November , 2015 or latter. Jan J Danielski, the Canadian Commissioner to New York 2016 reminds Canadian applicants to New York 2016, that this is a slow process and to be patient.

After the selection of exhibits is made, then the accepted exhibitors have to submit payment for the New York 2016 frame fees and the contribution to the Canadian commissioners' travel costs. After the frame and commissioner fees are submitted then the organizing committee will go about the task of matching the exhibits to the nominated jurors.

A quick calculation shows that a number of exhibit applicants will be disappointed. Also with the very high interest in New York 2016, a number of the nominated FIP jurors will also not be accepted.

Other exhibitions need You!

If the numbers game works against your exhibit and it is rejected, this happened to me personally in Washington 2006, there are many other FIP or FIAF exhibits looking for entries. Phila-Taipei 2016 FIP in Chinese Taipei and Córdoba 2016 FIAF in Argentina are available [details in the sidebar and on page 2].

Canada at New York 20-16

The RPSC will have a society booth at New York 2016 near the back of the food court. Be sure to stop by and say hello. Or better yet, volunteer to work a shift at the stand. The PHSC and the BNAPS will also be represented. Look for the Canadian exhibits in the 4,000 frame display area including the prestigious Court of Honour. Jim Phillips of Canada Post Marketing in Ottawa has just confirmed that Canada Post has taken a booth in the Postal Administration section to the left of the main entrance.

Sale of frames

2,000 brand new, "A" type, light weight, plastic and metal philatelic display frames are being manufactured for the New York 2016 exhibition. These frames will be sold after the event. Perhaps your local stamp club needs to replace it's older style, worn out frames for a set of shiny new ones or to add new frames to your inventory for that next big show you are planning. The surplus New York frames may be the answer. The RPSC is looking into the feasibility of a bulk frame purchase that may help local clubs and also cut freight and customs charges. Please en-
