AUSTRALIAN PHILATELY

The Australian Philatelic Federation (APF) is the national organization that supports organised philately in Australia and represents Australian Philately on the world scene. A number of national level stamp exhibitions are held annually. One feature of Australian national shows is that they usually feature restricted philatelic classes.

For example, the **October 6th-8th, 2017 Adelaide STAMPEX 2017** in South Australia has National Classes: of (FIP judged) Classes – Aerophilately, Astrophilately, Open Philately, Maxiphily, Revenues and Literature. APF (non FIP) Classes First Day Covers, Frugal, Polar, Cinderellas, Picture Postcards, and APF National One Frame in all classes. An interesting feature of this year's Adelaide STAMPEX show is that Canadian entries are solicited from RPSC members. A Canadian Commissioner and Juror has been appointed to carry RPSC ex-

Congress Hotel in Prague, dates are **15-18h August 2018**, capacity is 1,500 exhibition frames (approximately 300 exhibits) and Specialized FIP Exhibition classes are 1) Traditional Philately, 2) Postal History, 3) Philatelic Literature, 4) One Frame Exhibits, 5) Modern Philately, 6) Open Philately.

The Canadian Commissioner will be appointed in mid-May 2017. **The deadline for Prague 2018 entries to the RPSC Commissioner will be November 20th, 2017.** I expect that the 1500 frames may be oversubscribed with interest from FEPA and world collectors. I have been to Prague and it is a beautiful, historic city.
