Hello Fellow Exhibitors

This month's issue starts with a correction on the **South African Virtual Philatelic Exhibition SAVPEX 2020** Canadian results. There were 11 Canadian entries from 8, not 7 exhibitors. Three exhibits were attributed to Don Hedger instead of two and Neil Donen's exhibit was missed in the listing. Neil's exhibit received 92 points providing Canada with three 92 point exhibits from Messrs. Donen, Chiu and Hickson. The highest score on the exhibition was 93 points. 76th FIP Congress. FIP announced on August 9th that the 76th FIP Congress will not be held as planned on November 11th at Indonesia 2020, however, no alternate venue or date has been selected. The FIP board has re-opened nominations for the various board and commission positions and also re-opened the time line for member federations to propose motions for consideration at Congress. The 76th Congress will probably be delayed until Philanippon 2021 in August or Cape Town 2021 in November of next year.

As mentioned last issue, the **EXPOJAFIL 2020**, Mexican national level exhibition in Guadalajara, Mexico will continue this year as a virtual exhibition, Oct 17-24, 2020. All 13 FIAF members were invited to enter two exhibits and the invitation was fully subscribed. Entries from **Rob Lunn** and **John McEntyre** were accepted from the Canadian entries. Congratulations and best wishes to Rob and John in the EXPOJAFIL 2020 show.

EXPO –FAEF 2020, a national level virtual exhibition in **Argentina**, has invited Canada and other FIAF members to participate in this virtual show. The exhibition will run Nov 2-30, 2020 and will include exhibits in Traditional, Postal History, Aerophilately, Postal Stationery, Thematic, Maximaphily, Modern, Electronic Literature, Revenues, One Frame, and Picture Postcard Classes. A parallel youth exhibition is also being held. Although this is a

national exhibition all invited countries were asked to assign a national commissioner to be responsible for all communications and submission of entry forms and exhibit scans. Canada can submit eight exhibits for EXPO FAEF 2020. First priority on entries will be given to those who applied for Expojafil 2020 earlier in August but were not accepted. An English translation of the exhibition regulations is available from the national commissioner, David McLaughlin at email david.mclaughlin@rogers.com. Entry forms will be available in the near future.

Philanippon 2021 is planned for Yokohama Japan August 25-31, 2021. The Philanippon exhibition will be an FIP World Stamp Championship exhibition.
