The **London 2022** exhibition renamed from London

The Organizing Committee for Philanippon 2021 is uncertain if the ban on international visitors which the Japanese government put in place for the 2021 Olympic Games will be extended beyond the Olympic games and affect Philanippon 2021 which is scheduled to start 2



weeks later. As such, they have asked that all exhibits be shipped

by EMS courier service instead of being hand carried by the commissioners. As shipping by EMS will impact our exhibitors' insurance coverage, Canada has withdrawn from the Philanippon 2021 exhibition. I want to thank Ingo Nessel for acting as commissioner for our Philanippon 2021 program and all of the exhibitors who applied to exhibit at Philanippon. It is unfortunate for Philanippon 2021 and for all of international exhibiting that Covid continues to affect the hobby in this manner.

Last year at SAVPEX 2020, the South African national One Frame Virtual exhibition, Canadian exhibitors entered 11 exhibits. We have again been invited to participate in **SAVPEX 2021**, the 7th edition of this annual virtual event. John Wilson has been nominated as a Canadian national judge on the jury. One-frame exhibits may be from the following parent classes: Traditional, Postal History, Thematic, Aerophilately, Revenue, Postal Stationery, FDCs, Open, Picture Post Cards, Marchophily & Modern. Canada Post has committed to a super booth and they will also have a stamp launch at the exhibition. Booth registrations are being finalized. As of April 22, 2021, eleven countries have assigned commissioners including five of the ten largest exhibiting countries. Sponsorship discussions are in progress with a number of parties.

With **Canpex2021**, completing in a few days, I want to thank John Sheffield, Steve Johnson and the Middlesex Stamp Club for undertaking this project and to thank all the entrants, exhibitors, judges and bourse members for their support in the success of Canpex 2021, Canada's first national level virtual exhibition.
